Subject: Summary Of Reports Received:

AAE – A report by the AAE Executive Director, Mr. Ken Widelkam is attached. In summary:

- 2018 Marked the AAE's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary, celebrated at the annual meeting in Denver, Colorado.
- At AAE18, the General Assembly elected in a new slate of officers for the AAE, Foundation and American Board of Endodontics. Dr. Patrick Taylor is the current President of the AAE.
- The 2018 Fiscal year ended with a total of 8,022 members. Of note was the continued increase in the number of International members. The AAE recently completed a survey of these international members to better understand their needs and enhance the services and resources we provide. The results will be reviewed at the fall 2018 AAE board meeting.
- AAE Connection, an online community for members has continued to grow.
- Meetings in FY19 have included a joint Congress on Dental Traumatology held with the IADT in San Diego, California in August. Upcoming meetings include Insight Track Surgical Workshops in Chicago in November and an Insight Track CBCT Overview in Squaw Valley, California in January.
- AAE19 will be held April 10-13 in Montreal Canada. Record attendance is expected. A preview of the meeting is available online and registration will open in the coming weeks:

CAE - A report was submitted by Dr. Ian Watson, Canadian Academy of Endodontics Executive Director. In summary:

- The CAE will hold its annual session in Vancouver, Canada on October 16-20, 2018 lead by President Dr. Natanya Padachey. Pending a vote of the general assembly, the presumptive president for 2018-19 will be Dr. Maneesh Sharma and the vice president Dr. Shayne Lipton.
- The next meeting will be in Mt. Tremblant on September 19, 2019.

Mexico – A report by AMECEEE President Dr. Marco V. Zaldivar is attached. In summary:

- The AMECEEE currently has 17 active state subsidiary associations, which carry out one or two congresses per year, There are 27 graduate programs registered with the AMECEEE.
- Membership includes 350 active members, of which 67 are new members who joined within the last three years.
