IFEA SECRETARY REPORT 2017

The Secretary continued to update the contact information of the **37** component associations/societies. Each individual society had to provide the list of its new Officers and contact information, but it is always difficult to collect all the information.

For the preparation of this Meeting, the Secretary contacted the different Organizing Committees to have their reports. We asked from the South Africans the final report of the 10th WEC, from Korea, the progress report of the 11th WEC and from India, for the 12th WEC.

The secretary has started to make a timeline to organize the schedule of all the Officers of the Federation.

Finally, I have happily enjoyed this Executive position with President Mark Wotzke, President-elect Luke Sung Kyo Kim, Treasurer Terry Farmakis and Past President Sam Dorn, and I hope to continue working to keep improving our organization.
