
### **Time Plan Progress**







### [1] Venue Floor Plan

At this stage, the income and expenses of the IFEA WEC 2018 Congress are ongoing. Final payments from the exhibitors are not yet received, and we expect that the figures below may vary due to exchange rates, because we are managing US dollar and Korean won accounts.
